Thank you for the time to meet yesterday. It was great to hear an update and learn about the next steps in the project. As we discussed, there are some immediate next steps that need to be taken related to the Strategic Reserve Fund grant awarded to HiTest Sand.

First, I would recommend getting in touch with Jaci Woodson on our Commerce team as she manages our contracts for this program. Jaci will have the best available information to you on what the eligible costs are, timing constraints of expenditures, and the administrative processes we need to move forward on.

Second, I would recommend connecting with Jeff Koffel of the Tri County Economic Development District. Jeff is familiar with your project having had discussions over time about the potential of the site in Addy and will hopefully be able to assist us with the grant contract.

It may be worthwhile for all three of you, John, Jaci and Jeff, to arrange a conference call soon to discuss the steps in the process. Let me know if I can help arrange that.

We will no doubt have more discussions soon, but I wanted to get the conversation started on the grant execution piece as we are constrained for time.
